

Registration Examination

CCHPBC's registration examination is generally held twice a year: once in late winter/spring and once in late summer/fall.

This webpage will be updated when scheduling details for Spring 2025 examination are available.

Candidates are required to complete three components of the registration examination:

- Clinical Knowledge and Theory Exam
- Performance-Based Assessment (practical exam)
- Online exam: Law, Ethics & Professionalism. Candidates are enrolled in the online course in Law, Ethics & Professionalism as soon as they have booked the date and time of the online exam. All 7 modules of the online course must be completed before the scheduled exam. The online exam is held in proctored computer labs.
