Under section 37.1 of the Health Professions Act, Dr. Michael Buna admitted to (1) practicing in breach of a prior consent order and his undertaking to have a chaperone present at all times during the assessment, consultation, examination and/or treatment of female patients, (2) submitting information to the College that was false and inaccurate, in that it represented chaperones were present during the assessment, consultation, examination and/or treatment of female patients when no chaperones had in fact been present, and (3) counselling a patient to advise the College that a chaperone was always present at her appointments when he knew that was not true and with the purpose of misleading the College and frustrating its investigation into his adherence to the terms of the prior consent order and his undertaking. Based on these admissions, Dr. Buna consented to an Order from the Inquiry Committee (1) cancelling his registration, and (2) providing that, following that cancellation, he is not eligible for reinstatement of his registration.
