Nature of Action: The registrant, Jamie Kidd, voluntarily entered into an undertaking and consent agreement with a panel of the Inquiry Committee of the College.

As part of the agreement, the registrant agreed to the following terms:

- 1. a one-week suspension;
- 2. a formal reprimand;
- 3. undertakings not to repeat the conduct;
- 4. completion of intensive remedial coursework on professional ethics; and
- 5. payment of a portion of the costs of the investigation in the amount of \$350.

Reasons: The undertaking and consent agreement relates to an investigation initiated by the Inquiry Committee on its own motion.

As part of the undertaking and consent agreement, the registrant admitted to:

- 1. not holding valid Standard First Aid/CPR-C certification between July 19, 2020, and July 12, 2023, thereby violating section 63.3 of the College's Bylaws (as they then were).
- 2. failing to cooperate with the College's investigation by not responding to College communications in a timely manner.

A failure by a registrant to meet Bylaw requirements impedes the College's statutory obligation to regulate the massage therapy profession in the public interest.

The panel of the Inquiry Committee is satisfied that the terms of the undertaking and consent agreement will protect the public interest.
