Continuing Competency Requirements

Obtain a minimum of 50 CE credits per QA cycle by completing all 5 steps of the Practice Support Program (PSP)

Ethics (min 4 hrs.)

Note: If reporting activities relating to Career-Span Competencies 1 to 6, these activities are considered related to "Ethics".

Career Span Competencies (CSC)

- 1. Act with professional integrity
- 2. Communicate effectively

- 4. Function in a client-centered manner
- 5. Work within areas of personal knowledge and skills
- 6. Maintain a safe work environment

PSP Step 3: Qualifying Learning Activities

Interactive Formal Courses

List provider, course name, date and number of hours.

Examples:

- Live (including in-person or online) interactive workshop, seminar or training when attendance is taken and monitored
- Electronically offered continuing education when two conditions are met: (i) attendance is taken and monitored, (ii) there is an assessment tool for the course

Self-Study

List details of articles, journals, texts, online research, and core knowledge self-improvement and number of hours.

Examples:

- Journal Review
- Text book relating to TCMA, biomedicine, or health care
- Self review of practice and core knowledge.
- Completion of recorded webinar

Structured Interactive Activities

List interactive meetings either live or through other means with other licensed health care practitioners. Provide names of groups or individuals with whom you participated and number of hours..

Examples:

- Study Group Live (In-person)
- Study Group online or telephone
- Peer Supervision, Clinical Round, or training group
