With the aid of a PowerPoint presentation, Dr. Michelle Payne, Practice Advisor, provided an overview of how drugs are regulated in the naturopathic profession.

THAT the CCHPBC approve a revision to the Scope of Practice for Naturopathic Physicians: Standards, Limits and Conditions for Prescribing, Dispensing and Compounding Drugs to remove the wording currently stated under the heading "New Drugs Approved for sale in Canada" and replace it with the following words:



Any new drug approved in Canada shall automatically be restricted until reviewed.

THAT the CCHPBC approve the removal of phenytoin (diphenylhydantoin), leucovorin and verapamil from the excluded drugs in the limits and conditions of the Scope of Practice for Naturopathic Physicians: Standards, Limits and Conditions for Prescribing, Dispensing and Compounding Drugs.

THAT the CCHPBC approve the removal of 5-fluorouracil (topical use only) from the excluded drugs in the limits and conditions of the Scope of Practice for Naturopathic Physicians: Standards, Limits and Conditions for Prescribing, Dispensing and Compounding Drugs.

THAT the CCHPBC exclude the following drugs in the limits and condition of the Scope of Practice for Naturopathic Physicians: Standards, Limits and Conditions for Prescribing, Dispensing and Compounding Drugs:

Avapritinib or its salts
Exagamglogene autotemcel
Momelotinib or its salts Sotatercept
Tarlatamab
Trofinetide or its salts
Danicopan or its salts
Fruquintinib or its salts

Ivosidenib or its salts Vorasidenib or its salts Eplontersen or its salts Lebrikizumab Talquetamab Zilucoplan or its salts
