Summary of Order: A Panel of the Inquiry Committee (the “Panel”) ordered that Mr. Lee’s registration be suspended to protect the public during an investigation, pursuant to section 35(1)(a) of the *Health Professions Act* (the “Act”).

The Panel directed the Registrar to notify the public that Mr. Lee’s registration is suspended, pursuant to section 39.3(1) and (2) of the *Act*.

Reasons: The Order was made regarding a complaint from a member of the public (the Complainant). The Panel found that there was a *prima facie* case that the Registrant engaged in sexual misconduct by using a mirror to look under the door of a washroom located in his Clinic while the Complainant was inside.

The Complainant reported the incident to RCMP. As a result, the Registrant was criminally charged with violation of section 162(1)(a) of the *Criminal Code*, namely, secretly observing or recording nudity in private place.

The Panel concluded that suspension is proportionate and necessary in this case to protect the public during the investigation or pending any discipline hearing. The Panel determined that interim measures lesser than a suspension would not sufficiently mitigate the risk that the Registrant will engage in voyeurism in some other manner while practising the regulated profession.

Important Note: Limits, conditions and suspensions ordered by the Inquiry Committee under section 35(1) of the *Act* are made to protect the public during an investigation or pending a hearing of the Discipline Committee. Measures taken under section 35(1) of the *Act* pertain to allegations which are and remain unproven unless admitted by a registrant or determined by the Discipline Committee.
