Nature of Action: On January 28, 2026, Sung Hyun La (the “Former Registrant”), entered into an Undertaking and Consent Agreement pursuant to section 33(6)(c) and section 36(1) of the *Health Professions Act* (the *Act*), following an investigation by the College of Complementary Health Professionals of B.C.’s (the “College”) Inquiry Committee into allegations that the Former Registrant engaged in sexual misconduct.

Background: Sung Hyun La was previously a College registrant and acupuncturist.

The College received a complaint involving allegations that the Former Registrant committed sexual misconduct during treatment. On February 10, 2025, a Panel of the Inquiry Committee issued an urgent interim order pursuant to section 35 of the *Act* prohibiting the Former Registrant from treating female patients pending the completion of this matter.

His registration with the College lapsed on March 31, 2025 due to failure to renew.

Resolution: The Inquiry Committee resolved to dispose of the matter by requiring that the Former Registrant undertake or consent to the following:

- ineligibility for reinstatement of registration with the College until October 29, 2035;
- a formal reprimand from the College;
- agree not to repeat any form of sexual misconduct;
- complete learning courses on professional ethics and boundaries upon application for reinstatement;
- pay a fine amounting to \$1000; and
- cover a portion of the costs of the investigation amounting to \$350.



The Inquiry Committee is satisfied that this resolution is consistent with the College's mandate to protect the public.
