FAQ

Q: Are the Learning Modules required in the form of College authorized courses that need to be completed?

No, the Learning Modules (LMs) are **not** College authorized courses. Licensees are not required to submit any learning activities associated with the LMs. These modules are designed to help licensees become aware of the new harmonized [Professional Standards](#), and to promote self-reflection and familiarity with how these Professional Standards are applied in practice. As the Professional Standards set out the *minimum* expectations for professionalism and ethical conduct, it is recommended that licensees engage with the LMs to understand current expectations and prepare for a knowledge check (quiz) in October/November 2026..

Q: Am I required to complete the transitional Learning Modules and report my learnings to the College?

You can review the LMs at your own pace, and there is no requirement to report the work you did to the College.

However, College bylaws require that you review the resources provided by the College on specific Professional Standards. We are releasing the LM resources, starting in April 2026, to give licensees ample time to learn and reflect on how the standards apply to their practice before completing the transitional phase knowledge check (quiz) in October and November of this year.

Q: Is the knowledge check (quiz) a requirement?

Yes, per the College's Bylaws, licensees must complete and submit an online knowledge check (quiz) administered by the College between October and November 2026.
