



# Fall 2026 Licence Examination

The next Licence Examination will be held in Fall 2026.

Applications for the Fall 2026 Licence Examination will be processed from **Monday, May 25, 2026**.

The deadline for the application, including related documents and payment, must be received **by 12 pm (noon) PDT on Friday, June 26, 2026**.

Candidates are required to complete three components of the Licence Examination:

- Online exam: Clinical Knowledge and Theory
- Performance-Based Assessment (practical exam)
- Online exam: Law, Ethics and Professionalism

## Theory Exam: Clinical Knowledge and Theory

**Date: October 13, 14 OR 15, 2026**

**Time:** Three hours

### **Locations:**

- Metro Vancouver
- Okanagan Valley
- Vancouver Island

The exam is held in a proctored computer lab. Venue details will be provided by email to exam candidates prior to the exam date.



## **Performance-Based Assessment**

Candidates can choose to attend the Performance-Based Assessment (PBA) on any one of the dates in the following weeks:

**Week 1: September 14 – 18, 2026**

**Week 2: September 21 – 25, 2026**

**Week 3: September 28 – October 2, 2026**

**\*Week 4: October 5 – 9, 2026**

The Performance-Based Assessment (PBA) will be held in Burnaby (Metro Vancouver). Venue information will be provided by email to exam candidates prior to their exam date.

## **Law, Ethics and Professionalism**

The LEP course will consist of seven (7) modules. At the end of each module, applicants must successfully pass an end-of-module quiz to progress to the next module. All materials and resources required to succeed are provided within each module. Successful completion of all seven (7) modules, with a score of 100% in each end-of-module quiz, is a pre-requisite to take the LEP exam. Candidates will be enrolled in the course after the application period ends.

The Law, Ethics and Professionalism Examination is a self-proctored examination that may be completed remotely from the candidate's home or another suitable location.



**Candidates may complete the examination at any time between October 19 and October 21, 2026. Each candidate will be permitted one (1) examination attempt only.**

**Time: 90 minutes**

### **Accommodation (related to disabilities)**

The College of Complementary Health Professionals of BC (“CCHPBC”) will provide reasonable testing accommodations to any exam candidate with an identified impairment, disability, condition, disorder, or other special need, in compliance with relevant legislation, including the Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms and the British Columbia Human Rights Code.

If you require accommodation for a documented disability, please submit your request for accommodation via the Licensing Portal by the application deadline, **Friday, June 26, 2026**.

### **Summary of Important Dates, Fall 2026 Licence Examination**

- **June 26, 2026, 12 PM (noon) PDT:** deadline for application and payment of exam fees, and applications for accommodation
- **August 26, 2026, 12 PM (noon) PDT:** deadline for Licence examination cancellation. Cancellation/refund policy is outlined under ([CCHPBC Schedule 2: Fees](#))
- **October 13, 14, 2026 OR 15, 2026:** Clinical Knowledge and Theory Exam, Metro Vancouver, Okanagan Valley, and Vancouver Island



- **September 14, 2026, to October 9, 2026:** Performance-Based Assessment, Burnaby (Metro Vancouver)
- **October 19–21, 2026:** Law, Ethics and Professionalism (LEP) self-proctored online examination, available remotely from the candidate’s home or another suitable location.
