SUMMARY PROTECTION ORDER

Pursuant to sections 126 and 259 of the *Health Professions and Occupations Act* [SBC 2022] c.43 and upon direction from a panel of the Investigation Committee, **THE REGISTRAR ORDERS THAT:**

JOHN PIDUTTI, ND, has the following restrictions on their practice of naturopathic medicine:

- a) John Pidutti, ND, is prohibited from taking steps towards the removal of a patient's clothing, including but not limited to unbuttoning, unzipping, or unfastening any article of a patient's clothing himself.
- b) For clarity, if John Pidutti, ND, considers it necessary to access a patient's skin for a therapeutic purpose and that skin is covered, John Pidutti, ND, must explain the area(s) he requires access to and the purpose of the access before he requests the patient to remove or unfasten the clothing themselves.
- c) John Pidutti, ND, must immediately post a notice, in a prominent position, on all online booking pages associated with John Pidutti, ND, the following statement:

John Pidutti, ND, has restrictions on his practice imposed by order of the Registrar of the College of Complementary Health Professionals of British Columbia, dated June 15, 2026. The order is available on the College website at:

- d) John Pidutti, ND, must also immediately post a notice, in a prominent and visible place in any waiting room of any clinic where he provides treatment a notice that is printed on 8 x 11 inch



paper and in large font stating in English the same notice as set out in paragraph (c).

- e) John Pidutti, ND, must also post in a prominent place in any treatment room where he provides treatment, a notice that is printed on 8x11 inch paper and in large font stating in English the same notice as set out in paragraph (c).
- f) John Pidutti, ND, must, by 6:00pm, every other Friday while these restrictions are in force, provide the College a copy of his appointment diary from the preceding weeks, including the names and contact details of all patients treated.
