This proposed citation is submitted to the Director of Discipline for approval pursuant to section 136 (2) (b) of the *Health Professions and Occupations Act*, [SBC 2022] c 43 (the "HPOA").

The College requests the Director of Discipline to issue a citation to the Respondent based on the following:

1. At all times material to the events and matters described in this Citation, the Respondent was a registrant of the College and practiced as a traditional Chinese medicine practitioner.
2. The Complainant was a patient of the Respondent and submitted a complaint to the College on January 24, 2024, in relation to the provision of traditional Chinese medicine services by the Respondent in Vancouver, B.C, on January 23, 2024.
3. On April 3, 2025, a panel of the Inquiry Committee (the "Panel") of the College disposed of the matter by requesting the Respondent to enter into an Undertaking and Consent Agreement pursuant to section 36(1) of the *Health Professions Act* [RSBC 1996] c. 183 (the "HPA").
4. The Respondent has refused to enter into the Undertaking and Consent Agreement proposed by the Panel.
5. On January 7, 2026, the Panel directed the Registrar to issue a citation pursuant to section 36(2) of the HPA.
6. The Respondent's alleged conduct may constitute professional misconduct contrary to the following sections of the HPOA:
 - a. Section 11 (1)(a)(i);
 - b. Section 11(2)(a); and



c. Section 11(2)(b).
